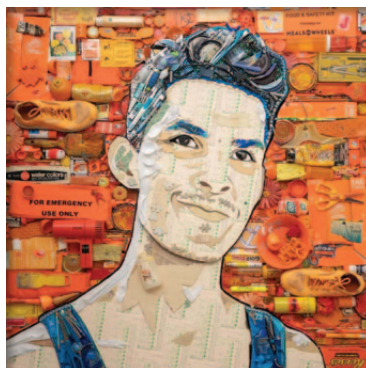


David • WASHINGTON
